This exam develops the mind of the students to analyse and apply the subjects that are taught in classrooms. After each round of 200 marks the top students are been awarded.

To showcase the talents in the subject of mathematics we had organised Maths Exhibition from standard 1-9 and most students with the support of their parents presented their models and explained before the judges. The prizes were awarded for each classes.

Motivational and spiritual Talks
